Price: Anthologies will sell for \$7:00 - \$8:00 depending on final size

Genre: Stories, Poetry, Drama, Lyrics, Cartoon/Comic, Memoir – any word-based work suited to print

ISBN/Archives: Our anthologies and ZineWest are each assigned an ISBN. They are archived by the National Library of Australia, and NSW State and Parliamentary Libraries in accordance with legislation

Themes: Night/Day; Time/Place (Other subject matter is welcome also)

- **Entry Limit:** Up to three entries per writer however only one or two will be included
- **Size Limit:** Entries need to fit into no more than two A5 pages which is approximately 600 words prose (less for drama and conversational pieces) and 60 lines poetry (including spaces between verses)
- **Layout:** Plain please, **no** decorated or image files
- **Font:** Face=Arial, Size=12 (cartoons exempt)
- **Paragraphing in Prose:** Line spacing single. New paragraphs tab .7cm
- **Dialogue:** 'Jack said, "Hello darling," which means he loves me,' said Jane.
- **Please check spelling, syntax, facts and legal implications**
- **DUE DATE:** Please submit entries from 1st Feb until 31st March 2010
- **Launch:** At Merrylands Library or Mars Hill Café in May/June

- **Windows Word Docs Only** We cannot convert mac files or image files
- **Cartoons/comics** are exempt from the ban on image files
- **Bio pics and illustrations** (optional) should be digital, separate files, sent as email attachments
